Warren Consolidated Schools Career Preparation Center named top Emerald School at Macomb County Green Schools Program

Warren, MI – The Career Preparation Center was named top Emerald School in Macomb County at the Green Schools Award Celebration sponsored by the Macomb County Board of Commissioners and the Macomb Intermediate School District.

More than 120 schools participated in the program, with Warren Consolidated Schools being the largest school district to have participation from its schools.

Schools are eligible to receive a Green, Emerald or Evergreen environmental stewardship designation. Points are awarded in 29 activities based on proper documentation describing how the school performed a minimum of two activities from categories such as recycling, energy, environmental protection and a miscellaneous category.

The following schools in the Warren Consolidated district earned designation in one of the categories: **Green** – Siersma Elementary

Emerald – Career Prep Center, Cousino High School, Butcher Educational Center, Beer Middle School, Grissom Middle School, Black Elementary, Cromie Elementary, Lean Elementary, Susick Elementary, and Willow Woods Elementary.

Evergreen – Community High School, Warren Mott High School, Carleton Middle School, Carter Middle School, Angus Elementary, Fillmore Elementary, Green Acres Elementary, Harwood Elementary, Holden Elementary, Jefferson Elementary, Wilde Elementary, and Wilkerson Elementary.

"These awards showcase the commitment Warren Consolidated Schools has made to increase our students' awareness to become environmentally conscious citizens," WCS Green Schools Coordinator Lynnette Macieczni said. "The teachers that volunteer their time to make our Green Schools program so successful deserve to be commended."
