The WPD believed this threat may be credible and out of an abundance of caution, they made the decision to end the football game and clear out the stadium. The investigation into this matter is ongoing.

I know I speak for all of us when I say how disappointing the conclusion of this evening was. Our community was together and truly enjoying the experience of watching our students compete and perform. It's a shame we did not get to see the final six minutes of what had become a very competitive football game.

With that said, I appreciate the response from the Warren Police Department, and their dedication to maintaining our safety. It is always best to err on the side of caution. As is always the case, we will fully cooperate with law enforcement as they investigate the threating report which was made earlier this evening.
