Creating Dynamic Futures

Proposal to preserve our schools and remain comparable and competitive as one of Michigan's leading school districts

- Provides Essentials for a 21st Century Learning Environment
- Addresses Safety & Security, Technology, and Facilities
- Costs Approximately \$1 per Week for Most Homeowners

Why Now?

- Interest rates remain at historic lows, allowing \$134.5 million to be invested in our schools for about \$1 a week per home
- Staying ahead of technology is essential for today's learning environment
- To maximize our operating budget for in-classroom learning
- To best preserve our community's investment in millions of square feet of space across 27 facilities that, on average, are 40+ years old



Overview of Bond

\$134.5 Million Bond Program Features:

Technology \$25.3 Million

- Upgraded technology and infrastructure to support 21st century learning
- · Enhanced technology in each classroom
- · Mobile learning devices for students
- Replacement of obsolete computers
- Updated and expanded wireless network

District-Wide Facility, Safety, and Security Improvements \$75.1 Million

- · Secure entry vestibules
- Security card reader systems for doors
- · Security cameras
- · Roofing and flooring replacements
- Upgraded fire alarm panels
- · Replacement of interior and exterior doors
- Improvements/upgrades to HVAC, plumbing, and lighting/electrical systems
- Renovations/improvements to restrooms, locker rooms, and cafeterias
- Energy enhancements
- LED exterior light upgrades

Sites, Fields, and Playground Improvements \$21.2 Million

- Re-pavement of deteriorating parking lots and sidewalks
- Replacement of worn fences
- Upgrades to athletic fields, courts, tracks, etc.
- Upgrades to playground areas

Bus, Furniture, and Equipment Replacement

\$12.9 Million

- Replacement of worn, unusable classroom furniture
- Replacement of school buses past useful life
- · Necessary band, athletic, and recess equipment

Benefits of the Bond:

- Creates modern learning environments so all kids can benefit
- Provides school safety and security enhancements
- Reduces utility costs through environmentally smart upgrades
- Maintains strong schools, which is an investment in the community and home values

Bond Considerations:

- Work to be performed from 2016-2021
- Bond sold in two series 2016, 2019
- All educational facilities to see initial improvements in 2017 with incremental upgrades over remaining term
- Each educational building will receive annual technology upgrades during term

Item	Description of Work to Be Done
Playgrounds	Underdrainage replacement, Wood fiber replacement, and equipment replacement & accessories
Ballfields	Fencing Replacement and Repairs, Bench replacement, and Infield mix replacement
Parking Lots	Repavement, additions, extensions, seal coats, repairs, collars, restriping, and sidewalk repairs
School Signs	Installations and replacements
Stage Curtain	Replacement of stage curtains and rigging
Boiler	Boiler equipment replacement
Exterior Lighting	Replacement of parking lot lights to LED, and replacement of exterior building lighting
Security	Replacement of secure entry equipment at selected areas and replacement/new security cameras
Network	IT cabling, wireless system upgrades, network switch gear, and universal power system (UPS) installation
Phone	VOIP Phone System Installation with Unified Messaging




Cousino High School Athletic Field


