(If you do not have birth certificates, you must be able to bring a recent, official documents that verify child's date of birth and that you are the parent or legal guardian. Documents such as recent DHS case notice, shot records, school records, etc. More than one document may be needed for verification.)

You will be asked to verify the household's monthly income on the application.
